The Clemson Little Theatre's Season Planning Committee is preparing for the 2012-2013 season of The Clemson Little Theatre (CLT) and the Clemson Area Youth Theatre (CAYT). We are soliciting responses from prospective directors, such as you, as to their interest in directing for CLT and CAYT. Other ideas, such as leading a workshop, directing a reader's-theatre production, or hosting a participatory play-reading event are also welcome. Once we have a pool of prospective directors, we will begin the process of selecting the season.

As you might imagine, planning a season takes time. The season must be as balanced as possible, and in this economy production budgets are a prime consideration, as is the selection of plays that will have strong audience appeal and support.
